About the role

This is a demanding and exciting role for a multi-skilled individual looking to gain experience in marketing, recruitment and project management. In your first year you will be responsible for helping Team Up to successfully market our volunteer opportunity and to ensure that the right volunteers are selected onto the programme. You will be working to motivate and manage our university societies who will be delivering our work on campus. Your goal will be to help Team Up meet our annual recruitment targets, planned to grow significantly over coming years. In your second year you will take on more responsibility for the strategic direction of our marketing work, alongside responsibility for delivery.

Team Up is seeking someone with ambition and high professional standards keen to develop themselves in an environment that rewards entrepreneurship and accountability for results. If you are committed to making a difference to young people and to your own development, this is the role for you. You will be joining a small team of staff in a fun and friendly environment where we work hard for the mission and for each other, and we look forward to welcoming you on board.

Key Responsibilities

1. Marketing

- Delivering Team Up's marketing strategy to recruit volunteer tutors from around London, including:
 - Presenting the Team Up opportunity to 6th form college students in assemblies and other settings
 - Building relationships with university stakeholders
 - Reaching out to retired and professional volunteers
 - Ensuring Team Up is using all available marketing channels to promote it's volunteer opportunities
- Managing Team Up's university society teams across 7-10 universities in London who support the work of Team Up on campuses

2. Screening

- Organising and running assessment centres to screen candidates including
 - Logistics and delivery
 - Responsibility for coordinating and managing staff
- Ensuring that all volunteers complete a DBS check
